AGREED ORDER GRANTING PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND DISMISSING CERTAIN CAUSES OF ACTION

Pursuant to the agreement of the parties, the Court hereby ORDERS that:

A. Defendants and any other persons acting on their behalf are PERMANENTLY ENJOINED AND RESTRAINED from (i) punishing or taking any adverse action against Plaintiff Cross for his speech at the Loudoun County School Board meeting on May 25 or any disruption caused by such speech, and (ii) punishing or taking any adverse action against Plaintiff Cross for any of his speech regarding any issues related to gender-identity or gender-identity policies from May 25 through the date of this Order, or any disruption caused by such speech. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to prohibit Defendants from enforcing Policy 8040, Rights of Transgender and Gender Expansive Students, or to take disciplinary action for violations of such Policy.

- B. Subject to the orders set forth in paragraph A, the First, Second, Third, and Fourth Causes of Action are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
- C. All claims in the First Amended Complaint against Defendant Lucia Villa Sebastian are dismissed with prejudice and she is dismissed as a party in this action.
 - D. This Order shall supersede the Agreed Order entered on November 15, 2021.
